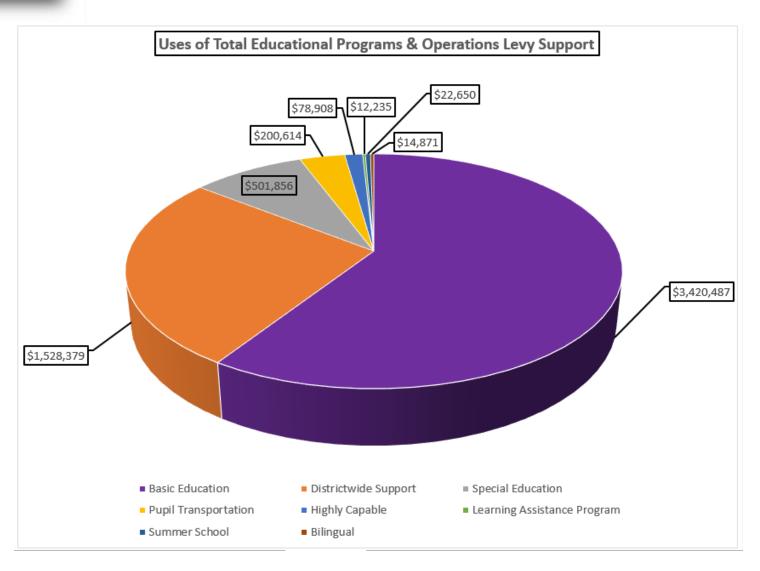
- Sequim Schools collects \$5.78 million in voter approved Educational Programs and Operations (EP&O) Levy each year.
- Voters approved a 4 EP&O Levy in 2013 for collection from 2014-2017.
- This presentation shows the budgeted uses of EP&O funds from 2016-2017.
- The 2016-2017 uses mirrors uses in prior school years.



- EP&O Levy Funds are used in eight different programs
- The use of levy funds is approved by the district's Board of Directors when they adopt the annual budget
- This table shows how much of the EP&O Levy is spent in each of the eight programs. Following slides will show the breakdown of uses in each program.

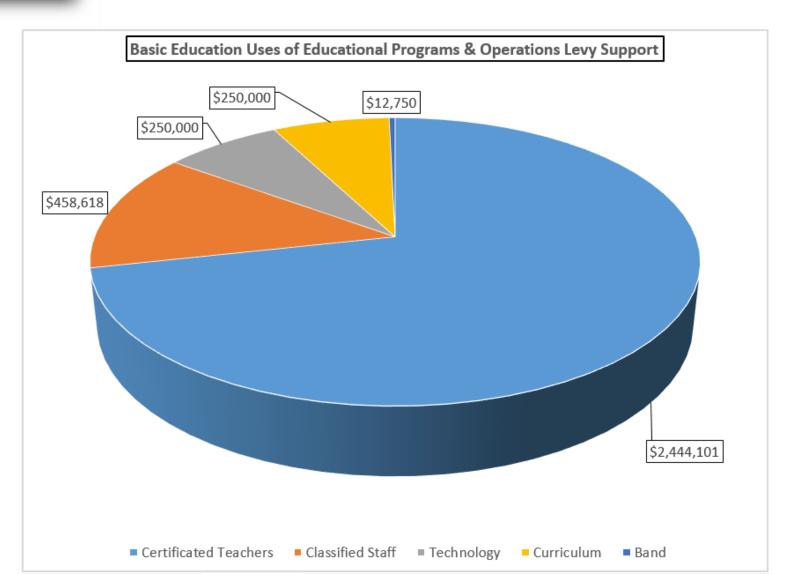




- The Basic Education Program receives the largest allocation of EP&O Levy Funds
- Salary and Benefits for the equivalent of 32.5 full time teachers is the largest use of EP&O Levy Funds in Basic Education
- Salary and Benefits for the equivalent of 16 classified staff (classroom aides, library aides, health room aides, building secretaries) is the second largest use of EP&O Levy Funds in Basic Education
- Technology and Curriculum are each allocated \$250,000 in EP&O Levy Funds
- The High School Band receives \$12,500 from EP&O Levy Funds for instrument replacement

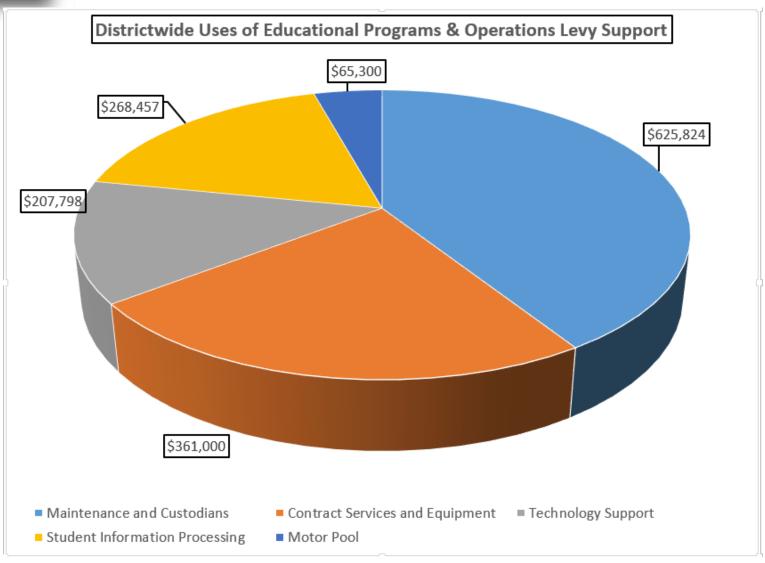




- The Districtwide Support Program receives the second largest allocation of EP&O Levy Funds
- Salary and Benefits for the equivalent of 17 Maintenance and Custodial Staff is the largest use of EP&O Levy Funds in Districtwide Support
- Purchases of Contract Services for building maintenance receive \$361,000 of EP&O Levy
  Funds
- 2.2 Technology Support Staff are funded from EP&O Levy Funds
- EP&O Levy Funds also support Student Information Data Processing Systems
- The Motor Pool receives \$65,300 from EP&O Levy Funds for fleet vehicle replacement

| Districtwide Support            | EP&O Levy Support | %      |

| Maintenance and Custodians      | \$625,824         | 40.9%  |
| Contract Services and Equipment | \$361,000         | 23.6%  |
| Technology Support              | \$207,798         | 13.6%  |
| Student Information Processing  | \$268,457         | 17.6%  |
| Motor Pool                      | \$65,300          | 4.3%   |
| Total                           | \$1,528,379       | 100.0% |







- Remaining EP&O Levy Funds support
  - 14 classroom aides (paraeducators) support Special Education students
  - Pupil Transportation receives EP&O funding to support purchase of liability insurance and fuel for school buses
  - The Highly Capable program is funded for 1 Teacher from EP&O Levy Funds.
  - Support for the State Transitional Bilingual program is provided to help students gain English language skills.
  - Summer school allocation provides certificated staff and supplies for students attending summer programs.
